

POSITION: NSW state-wide Fish Habitat Panel

This is a volunteer role. Meeting costs (catering, venue hire, etc) and travel expenses (accommodation, food, fuel, etc) will be covered by OzFish Unlimited.

OzFish Unlimited is a passionate NGO dedicated to helping the millions of Aussie recreational fishers take action for the health of their waterways and shore up the future of the sport they love. OzFish Unlimited partners with fishers and the broader community to invest resources into protecting and restoring our waterways, counteracting decades of degradation.

We are launching a state-wide Fish Habitat Panel for eight OzFishers to help drive change across NSW. The selected committee members will be provided with support and resources to deliver on-ground action. By creating two-way flow between local anglers, experts, and scientists, we can make more informed decisions that better align to local habitat and community needs. To be considered, you must be an active NSW OzFish member.

Outcomes of panel:

- More recreational fishers supported to take greater actions to improve fish habitat, resulting in better fishing outcomes and experiences.
- Building capacity across NSW OzFish Chapters by sharing ideas, knowledge and advice gained from lived experience in your local area.
- Learn from industry experts about habitat issues and help form solutions together.
- Improving the social licence of the recreational fishing sector by showing sustainability as a core value of recreational fishers.
- Genuine two-way flow between local anglers on the ground and experts and scientists, sharing ideas and forming solutions to habitat and community needs.

What can you expect?

- The panel will meet quarterly either in person or online to discuss local challenges, share knowledge, hear from industry experts, and form solutions, together.
- Each meeting will be a 'round-the-table' style chat, to hear about local issues, successes, and an
 opportunity to act as a support network where you can share ideas and ask questions.
- Unless there is an opportunity to meet in person, it is likely that most meetings will take place online via Microsoft Teams meeting in the comfort of your home.

*Panellists will be required to re-apply each year, with a maximum of a three-year term.
