



Position: Project Officer – Casual (this is a Casual Pool position)

Status: Casual (hours vary depending on role/need)

Remuneration: Variable depending on role, minimum \$28/hr (+ 25% loading) out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed as per OzFish Travel Policy.

Location: Variable, OzFish operates in all Australian States and Territories and will require casual roles in all from time to time.

At this time your application will be assessed for suitability to OzFish's Casual Staff Pool, and interviews will determine successful candidates. You will be notified by email of your acceptance or otherwise.

Please be aware that you are applying to OzFish's Casual Staff Pool, if successful you will go into a pool for potential employment as casual work opportunities arise that you might be suitable for. You will be contacted only if required. There is no guarantee that you will be contacted for work in any 12-month period.

Applicants should be aware that working opportunities may be remote or outside of their local area. Please indicate in your application if you are willing to work outside your local area (150km) for shorter or long periods of time. Travel costs to the place of work will be covered on a case-by-case basis.

This role is highly dynamic and specific to current projects at the time. In general, you will report to the Program Manager, and be responsible for:

- Assisting with **on-ground activities** (aquatic restoration actions, habitat installation, data and monitoring etc.)
- **Engaging recreational fishers** in OzFish activities including supervising volunteers.
- Communication and **promotion** of OzFish activities through news and media.
- General **administrative support** for OzFish Program Manager.
